Hello from Equine-Assisted Therapy, Inc, (EAT). We are a 501c3 nonprofit that provides horsemanship activities to those with mental, physical, or psychological disabilities and challenges to enhance the quality and productivity of their lives. We turn no one away for financial reasons, and never charge veterans, first responders or children in the foster care system.

What is Equine Therapy? Equine therapy is the use of horses and Certified Equine Therapy Instructors to enhance physical and emotional healing. Our focus is to not only help our clients well being but to gain strength, balance, and self-esteem all while bonding with their 1200lb teammate.

We work with together with many community programs like DASA, Cancer Support Community, Foster & Adoption Coalition, United Stroke Assoc., Alzheimer Assoc., Veterans, First Responders, county and city school districts, and many more. We are now in our 19th year and provide services to more than 150 participants a week plus groups at our two St. Louis County locations and use 150 trained volunteers each week. We are the only equine therapy service in St. Louis County.

Our Annual *Hoedown for Hope* is our primary fundraiser that helps fund our participant scholarships, feed, and care of our horses, as well as helps to maintain our twenty-five-acre property used solely for the purpose of our mission. This event typically draws 350-500 guests and includes live music, a catered dinner, beverages, with a live and silent auction, plus activities for children.
